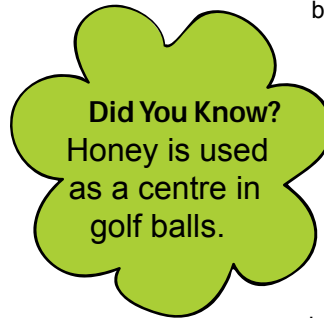
More Donations...

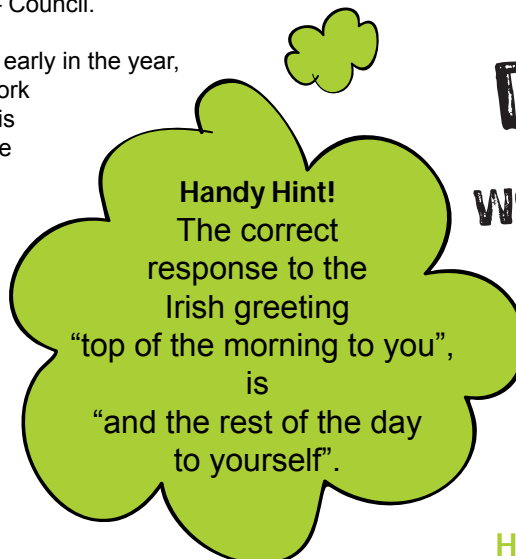
Fernlea House Inc. is dedicated to providing homelike community hospice care to people with life-threatening illness and to supporting those close to them.
